

Unfortunately the pandemic made it impossible for our annual concert to be held last March. **We now look forward to Saturday, March 5, 2022, as we celebrate 25 years of friendship, music, magical evenings and the pride in over \$750,000 raised by a group of like-minded community members supporting a wonderful cause.** We want to celebrate 25 years of successful fundraising and the amazing work that ARFC has done and continues to do for those impacted by the AIDS crisis. Our aging Committee feels it is time to look back with pride at our collective accomplishments with one more fabulous Silver Anniversary celebration.

Since 1996, The Twilight Concert Committee has planned and hosted annual concerts at St. George’s by-the-River Episcopal Church to benefit the AIDS Resource Foundation for Children. 100% of the monies we have raised have gone directly to the charity. # ARFC programs: So much to be proud of

## **New Initiatives of ARFC, 2021 and 2022**

ARFC is excited to announce upcoming projects that will further serve communities impacted by HIV:

- Hope Village III Shelter Program (a partnership with City of Newark): A low-barrier shelter with strong case management support for homeless individuals.
- Ending the HIV Epidemic (a partnership with NJ Dept. of Health): A community engagement project that will bring together stakeholders across the state, lifting the voices of those directly impacted by the virus.
- Housing Development: As a leading HIV housing provider in NJ, in 2022 ARFC will continue to partner with housing developers throughout New Jersey to ensure opportunities for safe and stable housing are available to those most vulnerable. Housing is healthcare.

## **Salon: Transitional Housing for Women, 2018**

The Salon home is a retreat-inspired therapeutic community for up to 15 women living at the intersection of HIV and domestic violence or sexual assault. This transitional home delivers services designed to promote safety, health, and wellness, using a trauma-informed approach to care and treatment.

## **New Jersey HIV Housing Collaborative, 2017**

A statewide initiative that uses a “hotline” method to provide emergency housing placements to homeless individuals living with HIV. The Collaborative also links clients to case managers, medical care, behavioral health support, and options for longer-term housing. NJHHC works closely with case managers across the state to prioritize housing case management in HIV care, providing mentorship, training, and a facilitated professional learning community.

## **Project Nest: Transitional Housing for Young Men, 2016**

This initiative is a safe space for young gay/bisexual men impacted by HIV/AIDS. The home addresses the medical, psychosocial, and skills-building needs of individuals who have been turned away from their families and have been living transient lives. Project Nest serves a total of 15 residents at a time, with case management services provided after graduating from the home.

## **St. Clare’s Housing Program, 1993**

ARFC provides supportive housing to people living with the HIV/AIDS. These affordable desirable homes help families provide the stability needed to live healthy lives. ARFC provides supportive services to 199 families, and an additional 92 families live in housing provided by the organization.

## **St. Clare’s Social Services, 1990**

ARFC provides social services such as mental health support, medical care, substance-abuse prevention, support groups, and opportunities for families to meet and support each other in the community. There are more than 275 individuals and their families impacted by the services in this program.
